
## Routes to SFSU, Peter Biella's office in Fine Arts 532, and the *Anthropological Filmmaking* class, in FA 260



For a San Francisco Bay Area map, with routes to San Francisco State from the East Bay, Marin and south, go the the next page. Once you are on campus, the map to the left shows how to reach my office – FA 535 - and MY hardest-to-find classroom, the *Anthropological Filmmaking* class, FA 260.



Once you are on Holloway Ave at the south-east end of the campus, you can park anywhere. One hour and two hour free parking is available. If you want to stay longer, it's best to park in the garage. Follow Holloway Avenue to the turn-about and head up Font Blvd. When you reach Lake Merced Blvd., turn right and the quickly turn right again on State Drive. The garage is 150 yards down the road and to the left.



If you are coming from the north and crossing the Golden Gate Bridge, you are on Highway Pass through the bridge pay booth and move to the right lane. Set your odometer to 0. After four-tenths of a mile, take the first right hand exit for 19th Ave.,/ Highway 1.

Drive through a park and tunnel, then emerge on Park Precedio Blvd. Continue south through Golden

Gate Park. Once you are through the park, the name of your road changes to 19th Ave. The cross-streets are in alphabetical order, but once you hit Sloat and a huge mall on the right, the alphabet stops and you are almost at San Francisco State. At exactly 6.4 miles from the bridge toll booth you have reached the campus and will turn right on Holloway Ave. At that point, follow the directions for the two maps, above.

If you are coming from the south, drive north on 280 and look for a small sign that reads, "19th Ave., Golden Gate Bridge, San Francisco State" and others for "Highway 1." To take this right hand exit, stay in the left lanes of 280. Once you have taken the "19th Ave. / Highway 1" exit, get in the right lane. At the first stop light, go straight, crossing 19th Ave. and landing on Junipero Serra. Quickly change to the left lane and, at the first light, turn left onto Holloway. A few short blocks leads you to cross 19th Ave. Then follow the directions for the two maps above.

If you are coming from Berkeley or the East Bay, once you reach San Francisco, you are on Highway 101. Follow signs for San Jose until you are able to bear right onto Interstate 280 to Daily City. The exit after Monterey is Geneva Ave./Ocean Ave. Take it.

Bear right on the exit, go up the hill and you find yourself on Ocean Ave. You now have about two miles of stop lights and stop signs. You will cross Junipero Serra, a big 6 lane boulevard. Now, after three short blocks, you reach 19th Ave. Turn left on it, go past the mall, and at the following corner, turn right on Holloway Ave. Then follow the directions for the two maps above.
